


# Objective of ASEF

# Objective of ASEF

 To exchange views and information on commonly interesting technical issues among Asian Experts of Shipbuilding.

 To get consultative status with IMO to contribute IMO by expertise of Asian Shipbuilders.

#### History

#### 1<sup>st</sup> ASEF in 2007 in Tokyo, Japan

Resolution on the 'FRAMEWORK OF ASEF' was adopted.

It says that 'the Forum will explore the possibility of establishing an NGO with IMO-Consultative status.'



#### 2<sup>nd</sup> ASEF in 2008 in Changwon, Korea

Resolution on the 'ESTABLISHMENT OF ASEF' was adopted.

It says that 'ASEF will explore the establishment of NGO with IMO-Consultative status.'



• 3<sup>rd</sup> ASEF in 2009 in Shanghai, China More than 300 participants attended.



4<sup>th</sup> ASEF in 2010 in Kyoto, Japan
 Correspondence Groups on IMO-NGO issue and on Inventory of Hazardous Materials (IHM) were agreed to be established.



• 5<sup>th</sup> ASEF in 2011 in Busan, Korea 1<sup>st</sup> Face-to-face CG meetings were held.



• 6<sup>th</sup> ASEF in 2012 in Guangzou, China 2<sup>nd</sup> Face-to-face CG meetings were held.



 7<sup>th</sup> ASEF in 2013 in Kobe, Japan
 3<sup>rd</sup> Face-to-face CG meetings were held and CG on IHM was finished.



#### External relationship

- Association of Asian Classification Societies (ACS)
  - ACS delivers presentation at the annual ASEF every year
  - ASEF attends ACS Executive Committee Meeting with Industry every year
  - ACS and ASEF has cooperated on the work of Inventory of Hazardous Materials (IHM) both in the Recycling WG of ACS and the CG on IHM of ASEF
  - ASEF dispatches its experts to the ACS Seminar
    - 2013, ACS Seminar in Jakarta-SAJ(Mitsubishi Heavy Industry)
    - 2014, ACS Seminar in Jakarta-SAJ(Kawasaki Heavy Industry)

- Asian Shipowners' Forum (ASF)
  - ASF delivers presentation at the annual ASEF every year
  - ASEF attends AFS Shipping Forum held in conjunction with annual ASF meeting every year



- International Association of Classification Societies (IACS)
  - ASEF attends Council-Industry meetings and GPG-Industry meetings of IACS
- International Maritime Organization (IMO)
  - In 2012, ASEF took part in the steering group of IMO symposium on the Future of Ship Safety (FSSS)

#### **Current situation**

- Annual Forum
  - Annual Forums are held rotationally in Japan, Korea and China
- Participating countries
  - 13 countries: Bangladesh, China, India, Indonesia, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Singapore, Sri Lanka, Thailand, Vietnam

  - Japan Ship Technology Research Association (JSTRA)
